



What if we had only two baseball teams to root for? Where, other than the voting booth, do we only have 2 choices?

Independents and new parties – from urban and rural Texas -- are coming together this legislative session to ask you to support:

- Fair ballot access laws for new parties and independent candidates, allowing for electoral competition in Texas elections. It's called the Texas Voter Choice Act - HB3068.
- Ending one-punch straight ticket voting, joining 40 other states to encourage voters to think before they vote – HB 25.
- Protecting citizen rights to petition their local government, our *REAL* local control – a Texas constitutional amendment passed in 1912.
- Verifiable elections – no candidate wants to face an unverifiable recount.
- Stopping “Gridzilla”, aka the California Water Model – mass exportation of groundwater to dry areas, an already proven disaster. (Expect many bills delivering death by a thousand cuts to the next generation’s water supply.)
- The most comprehensive eminent domain reform in years, starting with the passage of Texans for Property Rights Coalition reform bills.
