Dear Chairman Guerra,

On behalf of the League of Independent Voters of Texas, an IRS recognized 501c4 non-profit organization, I am extending this invitation for you to debate the pros and cons of Proposition A on the November 2018 San Antonio municipal ballot.

It is our contention that Proposition A, if it were law today, would have allowed citizens to challenge SAWS' Vista Ridge water project by petitioning for a public vote.

We are hosting this debate on Tuesday, October 16, from 7 to 8 pm at the Pan American Golf Association Clubhouse at 2300 Avenue B.

We have invited Mr. James Murphy to speak for the passage of Proposition A. Mr. Murphy is a longtime, well-known and respected water attorney who has spoken many times before the SAWS Board.

With due respect, Mr. Guerra, because you have personally contributed \$25,000 to the "Go Vote No" campaign – which is perfectly within your rights to do as a citizen – your participation in this debate would be a good faith effort to show SAWS ratepayers you are truly concerned about them.

Mr. Brendan Gibbons of the Rivard Report has agreed to moderate this forum. We believe Mr. Gibbons is fully prepared to guarantee a fair and open debate.
