

# Bills for Hearing

## Senate State Affairs Committee 26.Mar.2021

---

### SB 4

- Requires national anthem to be played at games.

### SB 7

- Seeks to prevent felons from registering to vote.
- Prevents early voting clerks and others from soliciting applications to vote by mail.
- Requires positive affirmation of disability for vote by mail. Requires SSI, doctor, etc. to certify right to vote by mail.
- Also, other effects on mail voting, including electronic tracking of applications by SOS.
- Allows poll watchers more freedom to view counting of ballots.
- Disallows voting in tents or temporary structures or parking facilities.
- Restrictions on motor voting.
- Restricts hours of early voting to 7am-7pm
- Positively affirms voter right \*not\* to vote on everything.
- Requires video surveillance of vote recording and counting.
- Requires auditable paper trail.
- Disallows private donations over \$1000 for administering elections.
- Penalties for election fraud.

### SB 29

- Requires public school students to participate in sports based on biological sex

### SB 331

- Restrictions on voter interpreters

### SB 598

- Requires “risk-limiting” election audits within 24 hours of an election (pilot program first).

### SB 1018

- Automatic change of address if mail voting submitted with new address.
- Allows for mail vote curing.

### SB 1112

- Disallows suspension of signature verifications.

### SB 1113

- Withholding of SOS funds for registrars who fail to cancel voter registrations.

## SB 1114

- Requires notification of lack of citizenship from motor vehicle records.

## SB 1116

- Requires internet posting of election results.

## SB 1234

- Requires auditable paper records.

## SB 1235

- Requires SOS to have access to information in DPS database to verify accuracy of voter registration applications.
- Allows SOS to determine anyone who is “ineligible to vote”.

## SB 1340

- Extensive changes to voter registration laws

## SB 1387

- Requires voting machines to be manufactured by US companies.
